### **Guest of Honor:**

**Brandon Sanderson** writes epic fantasy books for Tor Books and children's fantasy books for Scholastic Press. In 2007, it was announced that he would be completing Robert Jordan's epic masterpiece, The Wheel Of Time. Brandon is a two-time Campbell award nominee; his books have been published in 14 languages.

### **Additional Guests:**

**David Wong** is the pseudonym for Jason Pargin, online humorist and author of *John Dies at the End*. Jason's path to publication could only have happened in the internet age. He originally published his novel on the web, where word of mouth gained it a cult following. He then sold paperback copies via a print-on-demand publisher, and again through word of mouth alone, sold enough copies that Hollywood came calling for the film rights and St. Martin's Press bought the rights for worldwide publication.

Pargin was also the webmaster and head writer of the humor site PointlessWasteofTime.com from 1999 until 2007, seeing traffic grow to more than five million hits a month. In 2007 he was hired as the Editor of humor site Cracked.com. In his time there traffic has grown more than 500% to the point that Cracked is now serving more than 50 million pageviews a month and is one of the most popular humor sites in the world.

Whether it's researching graveyards in Atlanta or the asylums of Victorian London, **Jana Oliver's** quest for new stories frequently strays off the beaten path. The fruit of that labor is her multi-award winning Time Rovers® Series. Set in 1888 London, the books deftly blend time travel, shape-shifters and Jack the Ripper. The series (SOJOURN, VIRTUAL EVIL and MADMAN'S DANCE) has received eleven awards, including the Prism Award for Time Travel and the Daphne du Maurier Award for Excellence in Mystery and Suspense.

Jana's latest endeavor is the Demon Trappers Series, a Young Adult urban fantasy set in Atlanta which will debut from St. Martin's Press in the summer of 2010.

## JORDAN CON 2009 DEALER AGREEMENT

The Agreement is Jordan Con's statement of Dealer policy. Please read carefully before signing. Please keep a copy of this agreement for your records. All checks and correspondence are to be mailed to , JordanCon Dealers c/o Age of Legends, LLC, PO Box 767353, Roswell, GA 30076.

1. Age of Legends, LLC Agrees to provide one (1) Dealer Table, and two Memberships to Jordan Con, April 17th-19th, 2009 hereafter referred to as Jordan Con, total cost of \$150 to \_\_\_\_\_, hereafter referred to as Dealer.
2. Dealer agrees to provide payment in full by February 1, 2010. No refunds will be given after March 15, 2010. Refunds will only be given in the event that the convention is canceled.
3. Jordan Con Agrees to provide table space, as specified above, to the Dealers at Jordan Con, at the Crowne Plaza Ravinia Camellia meeting room, barring any unforeseen acts of God which may occur prior to or during these dates to prevent space being available.
4. Dealer agrees that Jordan Con, its directors and its volunteers, shall not be responsible for items lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed during the convention.
5. Dealer Table space assignments are the sole responsibility of the Senior Director of Finance. Dealer agrees to keep the assigned area clean and be responsible for any damage caused by the Exhibitor / Dealer, Booth and Tables are to remain in the Specified space and configuration as placed by Jordan Con.
6. The rights granted to the Dealer may not be sold, sublet, given or otherwise transferred to any third party.
7. Dealer acknowledges that Jordan Con grants no terms of exclusivity or other licensing agreement to the Dealer.
8. Dealer agrees to do business only during posted hours and not to engage in any disruptive activities including, but not limited to: unloading and / or movement of merchandise into or through the Dealer Room area during business hours; packing and unpacking of merchandise outside areas leased to the exhibitor, excessive noise; or any activity deemed by Jordan Con to be disruptive to other exhibitors or not in the best interest of JordanCon or any of its participants (i.e. incense burning, excessively loud music, etc.).
9. Jordan Con does not obtain ASCAP / BMI licensing that will allow the use of live or recorded music at your Booth or Table. Dealers interested in playing copyrighted music must notify us in writing, and obtain the proper licensing from BMI at (800) 366-4264 and ASCAP at (212) 621-6000. If a dealer playing copyrighted music cannot produce the proper documents, Jordan Con has no choice but to request that the music be turned off.
10. Dealer agrees to display and / or sell merchandise, which is consistent with all International and US copyright and trademark agreements, as well as all laws of the City of Alpharetta and the State of Georgia.
11. Dealer agrees that any violation or breach of this agreement may result in the cancellation of this agreement and forfeiture of the Dealer's leased space without refund.
